## Permissible, traditional

At the request of the students and with the blessing of staff, we are making a slight optional change in school uniform. The current school uniform will remain as standard and expected wear on formal occasions in its entirety.

However, in keeping with the cultural traditions of Austria and in recognition of being comfortable in the warmer months, we are introducing optional summer wear as an alternative.

From the start of the summer term the following will be permissible as school uniform.

For girls, they may wear a school Dirndl as uniform. We have contracted a local supplier with a garment of outstanding quality and price. The school Dirndl will be bright red, with a blue apron and a white blouse. The price (at cost) will be Euro 68.00 for the Dirndl and Euro 18.00 for each white blouse. These will be available in the school uniform shop from 9th May and will be the only permissible Dirndl.

For boys, the standard school shirt and tie will be required, but they may wear medium-length lederhosen for the summer. These will not be stocked in the uniform shop but may be purchased privately for those who so wish.
