SAT information

St. Gilgen International School is now a recognized testing location for the SATs (Scholastic Aptitude Test) effective as of the January 2012 testing date.

What is the SAT?

The SAT is the most widely used U.S. college admissions test. It is required by virtually every American University as an indicator of a student's academic readiness for college. It also gives students a sense of how well they will be able to handle the study skills required for college course work.

Not only that, the SAT also provides the opportunity for students to connect to scholarship opportunities, learn more about their academic strengths and possibly place out of certain college courses.

Why is this important for StGIS?

Being a trusted, nationally recognized exam, the SAT is essential for any student interested in attending an American University. Open as a testing location to any high school student, St. Gilgen International School's profile will be more readily accessible to students and universities alike.

Guidelines during ski camps and weekend races

1. Preparing of equipment for the ski day

- Choice of skis (slalom or giant slalom: trainers will inform)
- Appropriate warm clothing
- Helmet is mandatory
- Slalom protection when applicable
- Sun cream

2. Assist StGIS staff / trainers with the gathering & carrying of materials (e.g. drills, gates, flags), packing the vehicles and associated race needs.

Represent StGIS to the highest standard at all times.

Assist in building the profile of the Ski race program, not simply participate.

Race team members must recognize their place on the ski race team as a privilege not a write.

3. After skiing, help unload bus and be in charge of one's own equipment:

- Wipe skis down so that they don't rust
- Place boots, gloves and ski clothing somewhere warm so that they can dry overnight.
- Keep ski pass somewhere safe and accessible since it is used all week.

4. Ski preparation after skiing: includes sharpening and waxing of the skis.

- Students should have wax and an edge sharpener, and one or two should also have a waxing iron.

5. De-Brief = Either directly before or after dinner, a daily meeting will be held to discuss the day's progress and the plan for the following day (i.e. what type of training, viewing video training footage, what equipment is needed, breakfast time, departure time etc.)

As each training / race approaches, I will send more information for each event.

We are working on getting a StGIS Ski team uniform / clothing.

Students are to keep themselves 'ski ready' by regular training and skiing. I will also increase the prevalence of school-based training. This will be called 'StGIS ski boot camp'. It is designed specifically for developing ski strength.

All parents and student to be aware of the dates and commitments.

Students need to have ski's, bindings, boots and other training / racing equipment ready!
